

## Summary of Cable Review Meeting

April 12, 2001

1. Fire mitigation for the far detector front-end readout cables is still under study. J. Oliver is shipping a cable-packed Zipper Tube sample to Fermilab for tests. J. Priest continues to conduct tests of fire retardant coatings that may be painted on or sprayed onto the cables. The coatings have the advantage that they can be applied to individual cables past the point where they would branch out of the Zipper Tubing and up to the termination point.
2. The grounding cable for the mux boxes is approved.
3. D. Saranen will search for plenum-rated, non-halogenated LAN cables as identified by K. Schuh. These cables are given provisional approval.
4. The new magnetic induction pickup (B-dot) cables are approved.
5. D. Boehnlein will continue to gather cable checklists for the remaining MINOS cables still needing review.
